Division Responsibilities

Each division will have an appointed Vice-Chair Person that will conduct all meetings and appoint sub-committees. This position will be appointed by the Chairman on the Board of the Lebanon Wilson County Chamber of Commerce and must be a board member of the Chamber. All meetings are at noon in the Chamber Board room.

The Membership Division is responsible for the recruitment and retention of members · The membership Vice-Chair shall serve as a member of the Ambassadors · The Membership Committee is responsible for attending Business After Hours, Business Before Hours, Business Card Exchange, Open House, and planning the Annual Membership Banquet · The Membership Division will recognize all new members at a scheduled orientation. MEET 2ND WEDNESDAY MONTHLY.

The Ambassador Program is a sub-committee of membership · Ambassadors are advocates of the chamber · Members are responsible for the delivery of Ribbon Cutting photos and thank you notes to new members · Ambassadors are also responsible for attending Business Before Hours, Business After Hours and Ribbon Cuttings. MEET 4TH WEDNESDAY MONTHLY.

The Special Events Division is responsible for hosting events for our community and the promotion of our community for the City of Lebanon · This division will work for the development of activities and facilities for our community in the area of recreational opportunities and entertainment · All monies received from the City of Lebanon shall be used for the promotion and development of community tourism in the City of Lebanon · The committee will develop programs for retail promotion and Small Business Saturday. MEET 3RD TUESDAY MONTHLY.

The Education Division promotes quality education throughout the county, city, and private school systems · The Education Division will continue the program of the Business and Education Coalition; providing grants to local teachers and seeking funds for these grants · Also is responsible for the education endowment and seeking funds and promotion for other programs including Wilson Books From Birth · This division will seek ideas and implement programs for better education in Wilson County · Committee will help plan, promote, and benefit from the “Taste of Wilson County”. MEET 4TH TUESDAY MONTHLY.

The Government Relations Division was formed to improve the communications with city, county, federal and potential county leaders. This division will create and conduct a leadership training class for all elected officials, department heads, and potential county leaders · The committee hosts a series of meetings focusing on issues of interest to Wilson County citizens; especially to members of the Wilson County Chamber of Commerce. MEET 3RD WEDNESDAY MONTHLY.

The Economic Development Division will address healthcare and workforce effectiveness and a community livability program · This committee tours industries/manufacturing businesses and provides Lunch & Learns regarding economic development related subjects. Hosts Industry Appreciation Day. MEET 4TH THURSDAY MONTHLY.

The Sports Council Division works to recruit and promote sporting events in Wilson County, and will encourage volunteer participation to assist with sporting events and sport related activities · This division will host an Annual Academic Banquet to recognize top student athletes from all Wilson County Schools and present a female and male Best-All-Around Student Athlete Award · Committee members assist with the fundraising needs of the chamber, including the Annual Golf Tournament, as well as partner with Cumberland University for the All Sports Camp and an annual Two Rivers Ford Bass Fishing Tournament.
